IDEAS FOR THE BIG DAY

Add some fun to your Big Jubilee Party with these easy-to make bunting biscuits! Once baked use icing to create patterns, write out a celebratory message, or set up a station so people can decorate their own on the day.

Un-iced biscuits can be frozen for up to three months so they're great for making in advance.

Make your own red, white and blue Bunting and decorate the outside of your house.


There are lots of ways to make you own bunting: you can paint sheets of paper or newspaper (remember to paint both sides) and when dry cut into triangles. Try mixing poster paint with some PVA glue to make it waterproof. Punch some holes and thread through some string, ready to hang up. Don't leave making the bunting too late or it won't be dry in time for your party! or

ask an adult if they have any strips of red, white and blue material you could cut up and thread with string or

if you have a printer you could download some templates and colour or paint them in.

FAMILY DAYS OUT IN THE NEW FOREST

New Forest Reptile Centre

The New Forest Reptile Centre is to be found at *Holidays Hill*, approximately 2 miles west of Lyndhurst.

It's a small but very worthy attraction and conservation centre where you can *(potentially...)* see all of Britain's reptiles in one place; adders, grass snakes, smooth snakes, lizards, frogs and toads are displayed in separate open air netted pens, with all reptiles living in their natural environment.

You can also take the Discovery trail - a short family friendly circular walk in the New Forest. Enjoy a circular walk through the woods. From the Reptile Centre car park, follow red marker posts along the main gravelled track, which is fairly smooth.
